

ALEXANDER CAMERON

Alexander Cameron, well known Rochester businessman and wholesale milk dealer, died suddenly at the Harper Hospital last Sunday following a heart attack.

Mr. Cameron had been a resident of Rochester for the past 20 years and prior to that time lived at Shabonna, Mich. He was born there Jan. 30, 1901, the son of Roderick and Mary Cameron, and was educated in the Sanilac County Schools.

He was a member of the Rochester Lodge, No. 5, F&A.M., and a member of the Rochester post of the American Legion. He served with the armed forces during World War II.

He made his home at 6360 North Rochester Road, where he lived with his sister, Miss Katherine Cameron, who survives him. He is also survived by another sister, Mrs. Vern Arnold, of the village and four brothers, Hector of Decker; Donald C. of San Francisco; Malcom and Allen, of Vancouver, British Columbia.

Funeral service was held yesterday at 2:30pm from the Nichols-Pixley Funeral Home with the Rev. Robert Burgess officiating. Burial was in Mt. Avon Cemetery.
