

TRUMAN S. TIBBALS

Truman S. Tibbals was born in Avon Township, November 8, 1834, and died in Rochester, Mich., October 3, 1901 being 66 years 11 months and 25 days old.

With the exception of a few months which were spent in the oil regions of Pennsylvania he lived in the township of his nativity.

For the past six years he had been a great sufferer, being afflicted with Bright's disease. Two years ago he built a comfortable house in Rochester and leaving the farm, moved into and enjoyed life as best he could under the circumstances. Possessed of a deep of love and home and his companion, he was seldom found elsewhere.

He was married to Rostra Koch October 19, 1865. there were no children born to them. Mrs. Tibbals survives him and will greatly mourn his loss as will also a large circle of friends for Mr. Tibbals was a man highly respected for his good principles and sterling qualities which combined to give him a strong personality.

The funeral services were held from the late home on Walnut Street, last Sunday afternoon, at 2 o'clock, Rev. K. N. Conrad, pastor of the Baptist Church, officiating.
